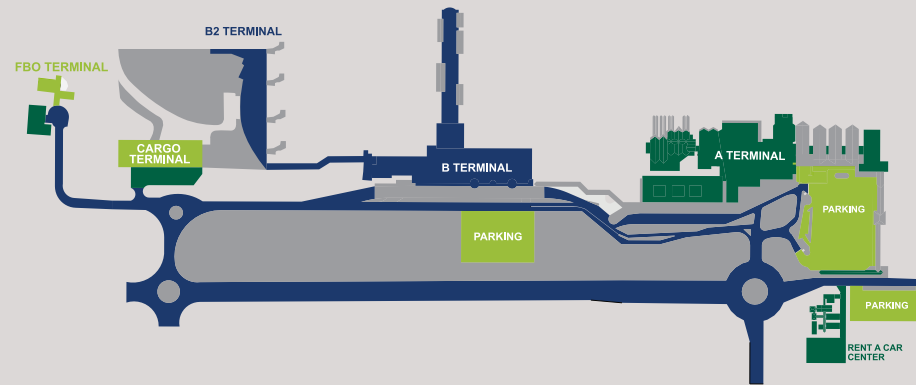

GENERAL INFORMATION



✈️ FBO Terminal:

Located on the west side of the International Terminal, the FBO serves executive general aviation from international and national destinations. Staffed by airport operations personnel, the FBO provides all standard general aviation and executive jet services.



✈️ Commercial Terminals:

With over 8 million international passengers each year, Puntacana International Airport is the largest airport in the Caribbean. The three terminals have a ramp capacity of 21 positions with a size of approximately 79,000 M².



✈️ Private Aviation:

Located on the east side of the International Terminal, the VIP Terminal is a private terminal and aircraft parking apron. Prior permission from airport management is required to use the private VIP terminal.



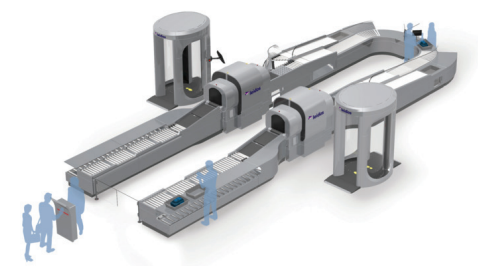

✈️ B2 terminal extension

We are currently developing the expansion of terminal B, with the aim of having a greater annual passenger capacity. Terminal B2 will be operational at the beginning of 2023 with an extension of 25,000m² that will give us the possibility of handling more than 2,500 passenger per hour.

The new extension will have 7 gates, 7 jet bridges, a VIP lounge with a pool overlooking the runway, a large food court, shops and service offices. The terminal is designed to be a benchmark of modernity and technology where we will have cutting-edge resources that will offer a memorable experience to our



passengers. Security and passenger services will be a reference in the Caribbean as we will install Security e-Gates in addition to 8 additional Body Scanners, 8 tomographic machines, 4 automated tray return systems that will significantly reduce the security process time when addressing. The investment for this expansion amounts to US\$ 80,000,000.
